

2011–2012 Pittsburgh Opera High School Apprentice Program



Students from a wide geographical region develop new friendships during the High School Apprentice Program.

Pittsburgh Opera offers a unique program each fall for up to ten high school students in grades 10–12 who may be considering a career in the performing arts or are interested in learning more about opera from behind the scenes. During four half-day sessions, apprentices learn about all Pittsburgh Opera departments, observe coaching sessions, and explore an academic project. In addition, students may choose to attend rehearsals and other events. Select students may be invited to participate again in the spring.

Application forms include an apprentice information form, a parental release form, a school administrator absence release form, and a contract for the student to complete. There is an enrollment fee of \$50 per student.
