Her lifelong love for opera combined with strong business expertise and determined leadership have been an invaluable resource in raising the artistic profile of Pittsburgh Opera, developing strategies for financial stability and raising commitment to education and outreach programming.

A native of Pittsburgh, Mrs. Bognar is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Bognar and Company, Inc., a producer of carbon products for the steel industry headquartered in Pittsburgh with manufacturing locations in Pennsylvania, Ohio and Indiana. Upon graduation from the Pinkerton School of Business, which was assimilated by Robert Morris University, she held a sales position with Anchor Hocking Glass Corporation and thereafter, a senior sales position at Union Mining Company.

In 1957, Mrs. Bognar and her husband became co-owners of Union Mining Company, now known as Bognar and Company, Inc. Since her husband's death, Mrs. Bognar has held her current position as Chairman and Chief Executive Officer.

For giving generously of both her time and expertise, Mrs. Bognar has been recognized by multiple organizations including the Performing Arts Partnership and Achievement Award from Point Park University in 1998 and an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters in 2000. She was also previously recognized by Pittsburgh Opera with the inaugural Minerva Award in 1998.
